01.07 students, 13 faculty members and 1 management member gave their feedback

02. Students feedback- it was received in very less number as compared with the total admitted students of the college , hence statistically we may not be able to rely on the responses however to take note of the same following is the outcome of students feedback in nutshell

- All the Students seem to be satisfied with the course content
- Few amongst them suffered challenge of English Language
- PG. student suggested LL.M Course of Constitutionalism needs to be placed in two parts
- Along with physical, online classes should also be kept
- 03. Amongst faculty members 61.5 % of the teachers are satisfied with the course content where as others suggested need to add few course such as Competition law, IT Act, Cyber Law Criminology penology and victimology, Law and medicine and Human rights.
  - Teachers expressed the need to revising the courses as follows

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- Family Law contemporary issues and challenges, senior citizens Act, PWDV to be added
- Syllabus and curriculum outline for LLM feels outdated especially in the corporate scenario, Every Year new Sebi Regulations kick in but our syllabus hasn't really moved out of 1956 Companies Act in spirit. Consumer Protection Act 1986 has also been replaced by CPA 2019
- Jurisprudence Syllabus is not properly framed, no basics are included, there are no objectives and expected out comes for the syllabus are decided.
- Practical subject should be promoted. Need to teach English grammar to those who are weak in it

- T.P. Act along with some Procedure for registration and recordation of property.
- Changing labour Codes
- Other Suggestions by faculty include
- Compulsory One month window dedicated for internships.
- All practical subjects and the assessment should be purely on "practical" basis only; there should not be any theory examination for practical subjects.
- Corporate visits

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- additional infrastructural facilities
- organization of additional seminar workshop and conferences, additional subscription of online content
- organization of training programme on Research Methodology
- additional subscription of online content, completely satisfied with the provisions made by the institution
