### **SEVEN DAYS RESIDENTIAL CAMP REPORT 2022-23**

National Service Scheme Unit of M.L&GE Society's Manikchand Pahade Law College, Aurangabad had organized a Special Unit Camp, on the theme Yuvakancha Dhyas Gram Shahar Vikas, at Khamgaon (Goraksha) Taluka Phulambri, Dist. Aurangabad from 02/02/2023 to 08/02/2023.

Before organizing the Special Unit Camp, the NSS programme officers and student volunteers visited the village to make necessary arrangement for the camp. The student volunteers were given training for the camp. Several meetings were organized for the said purpose. The students practiced street play on socio-legal topic to be performed in the adopted village. They also did practice for cultural programme. The planning and schedule of each day was systematically structured. The NSS Unit Camp was fully residential. The residential arrangements of student's volunteers were arranged in the Goraksha Sanstha in Ayurvedic Medical College hostel. The selected students' volunteers were divided into seven groups. Each group was given name of Forts. Each group had given the responsibility to conduct all the NSS activities of that day.
