## Report of Various Visits during the Academic Year 2022'-23

**Subject: Environmental Law**  
**Field Visit Report**

**Class: LL.B III & BA LL.B V Academic Year: 2022-23**

Environmental law is a compulsory subject for final year students of LL.B. - 3 years and five years BALLB Law degree programme. For better understanding of the subject two field visits were organized by the College.

On **29<sup>th</sup> September 2022** first field visit was organized at *Respirable Dust Sampler Unit of Maharashtra State pollution Control Unit for Observing Air pollution* placed at Environmental Science Dept. S. B Science College, Aurangabad, the college with which M.P. Law College is having MOU. The visit was arranged to give practical knowledge to the students and make them familiar about the procedure of detecting air pollution. Ms. Rekha Tiwari who is in charge of Research activity for this Unit, elaborated the entire mechanism of the instrument installed at terrace of the college. Ms. Tiwari and her team showed different parts of the instrument and explained how air sample is collected.



She also gave information of amount of the air pollutants such as ammonia, nitrogen, Sulphur dioxide etc. Later she explained the entire procedure with power point presentation in the interactive session followed by the visit in the same Department. Further the students visited the laboratory where the analysis of the sample is conducted

The second field visit was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022 at SMS Waluj CEPT Private limited, which is common effluent Treatment Plant, committed to treat effluent from various industries of MIDC Waluj. About 120 industries has joined SMS WCPL



for the treatment and safe disposal of their effluent. The students were divided into groups and the entire procedure was systemically explained by Mr. Gitesh Sabane , HOD of CEPT , Waluj .

For this visit two special buses were arranged, and both the course teachers accompanied students.







## **Visit to DLSA and Family Court**

As a part of Practical training course Alternate Dispute Resolution system the visit of students of LL.B. II was organised at the Family Court and also to District Legal Services authority's office on **12<sup>th</sup> April 2023** and **17<sup>th</sup> April 2023** respectively. In all around 80 students had joined for the visits.

In the Family Court Aurangabad students visited the court rooms in small groups and observed the proceedings. They observed few formal sessions with the counsellors. For having better idea about the working of the court special interactive session was organised with the Counsellors in the children's facility hall which is established by the family court where parents can meet the children during the pendency of their litigation. Ms. Vandana Kochar, Court Manager Family Court who is alumni of the college took great efforts for the session. In the beginning Dr. Aparna Kottapalle, course teacher who had organised the visit introduced the significance and expected outcome of the visit and the session. Ms. Sandhya Chavan Marriage Counsellor family Court Aurangabad guided students elaborated over all procedure and made students understand the significance of the role of Marriage Counsellor family Court. Another counsellor Smt. Jyoti Sapkal explained overall jurisdiction and working of the family Court. Students were having great curiosities which were pacified through the interactive session. Bharat Kale, Counsellor, Mr. Anil Jadhav Registrar Family Court, Dr. Sachin Deshmukh, Director Physical Education were also present during the discourse.

## **Visit to DLSA**

The visit of LL.B. II to District Legal Services Authorities was organised on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2023. During the visit students visited the office, observed the maintenance of record and then Interaction was organised in the conference Hall of the District and Sessions Court Aurangabad. The Session was Presided over by Smt. Vaishali Fadnis, Secretary DLSA. Adv. Shri Kailash Bagnavat , Adv. Smt Sarika Puri and Dr. Aparna Kottapalle, Course teacher and Visit Coordinator were present during the session on the dais.

The session was introduced by Dr. Aparna Kottapalle and explained how this session will benefit the Law students. Adv. Mr. Kailash Badanavat, Assistant Defence Lawyer appointed by the state through legal aid provisions guided the students on the criminal law practice and procedure in which the significance of role of defence lawyer he elaborated. Thereafter, Adv. Ms. Sarika Puri discussed the provisions and impact of Lok Adalat . Adv. Gulshan Mundada guided students on overall provisions of NALSA with special reference to Free legal aid and advice. After his speech Adv. Snadhya Rajput emphasised the importance of free Legal aid to woman. Students asked the queries which were satisfactorily answered by the dais. The concluding remarks were given by Smt. Vaishali Fadnis in her Presidential address. Madam, expressed satisfaction for the continuous activities and college linkage with the DLSA for more than 15 years. She helped students understand working of Mediation Centre and also of Pre marriage litigation Counselling Centre in amicable settlement of disputes. In her speech she motivated students to be a part of Pro bono activities. After this interactive session students observed few mediation proceedings at Mediation Centre.
